The Employer shall reply at latest seven (7) days prior to the deadline for submission of proposals.

Application in sealed envelope clearly marked “**Framework Agreement for Underground Works - CPB/37/2017**” and indicating the closing date should be addressed to **The Chief Executive, Central Procurement Board** and should be deposited in the Tender Box situated at the undermentioned address or sent by courier service or registered post so as to reach the **Central Procurement Board** on or before **Tuesday 12 June 2018 up to 13.30 hours (local time) at latest**.
