CEB Low Voltage Network Assistance Scheme (Displacement of Network)

Information and Criteria

The amount of the financial assistance of this Scheme depends on the household income of the applicant. This Scheme will not apply to households deriving a monthly income of more than Rs 22,500/- and will be subject to the following established criteria as from 26 October 2015:

<u>Gross Household Income</u>	<u>Maximum Assistance</u>
Less than Rs 13,500	Rs 65,000
Between Rs 13,501 to Rs 17,500	Rs 50,000
Between Rs 17,501 to Rs 22,500	Rs 35,000

The eligible applicant shall contribute for the amount in excess of the above threshold for CEB to undertake relevant works and pay.

The other conditions that apply to the Scheme are as follows:

- (i) It will be exclusively applicable to a **domestic consumer**, who can benefit from the Scheme only once and who is a first time owner of a house;
- (ii) An application for assistance should be submitted to the CEB on the prescribed form, available at any CEB Customer Services Centre;
- (iii) The applicant should **produce documentary evidence** that the CEB has not granted him/her clearance for a building/development permit or land use permit;
- (iv) The applicant will be required to swear an affidavit to confirm the level of revenue drawn by the household (specimen available at any CEB Customer Services Centre);
- (v) The assistance will apply only to genuine cases, where the CEB network is either hindering or posing a hazard to a residential construction.

It is to be stressed that this Scheme does not apply to Land Parceling projects, illegal parceling of lands, squatters, religious and charitable institutions.

The following documents need to be produced when submitting the application form:

- (i) Applicant's latest salary slip and a copy thereof. A copy of the salary slip of the Applicant's spouse must also be submitted, where applicable;
- (ii) An affidavit certifying the household monthly income (a specimen copy is available at any CEB Customer Service Centre);
- (iii) Identity Card of the Applicant and a copy thereof;
- (iv) CEB claim letter and a copy thereof;
- (vi) Documentary evidence that the CEB has not granted him/her clearance for a building/development permit or land use permit;
- (v) Title Deed or State Land Lease and copy thereof.
